HEALTHCARE CELL



Hidaya Healthcare Cell conducts annual free healthcare check-up camps, eye check-up camps and healthcare awareness camps in desolate areas of West Bengal.

HAJJ TRAINING CELL



Hidaya Hajj Training Cell conducts annual Hajj Training camps in different parts of West Bengal. It is the official partner of the Govt of West Bengal for imparting Hajj training and for Airport Haji Assistance.

Under Construction Hidaya Research & Training Centre (HRTC)



Hidaya Foundation Trust plans to execute its Research and Training activities from the proposed building. The details of the programme areas are as below:

TRAINING AREAS

UPSC/WBCS/Civil Services Training facility

Teacher Training: Training primary and high school teachers into modern, value based education techniques, using audio visual aides for effective learning, etc

Govt schemes awareness training: Whereby the details of available Govt schemes, qualification criteria, application criteria, etc shall be communicated to the masses

Govt scheme application training: Whereby the downtrodden and needy shall be trained in modern project planning tools, to effectively convey their needs for different Govt schemes, to prepare project reports and present their candidature for the relevant Govt Schemes

Parents training: Parents of children of the age of 6-18 years shall be periodically counseled on the merits of value based education and other modern teaching tools, so that they can appreciate and inspire their children towards better knowledge gain.

Deeniyat related trainings: Muallims, Maulanas, Muallimas associated with teaching Deeniyat courses shall also be trained here.

RESEARCH AREAS

Socio Economic Condition of Muslim population:

Conduct in-depth, grass-root level research in Muslim dominated areas to acertain the actual condition of the Muslim population presently and what are the distinct needs of different blocks and constituencies.

Correct utilisation of Muslim youth:

A large part of the talent hidden amongst today's Muslim youth is wasted in fruitless celebrations during religious festivals. HRTC will research how this lost potential can be utilised for the benefit of the Muslim population

Textile Industry skill development:

Majority of the skilled labour available in WB works in the textile industry. HRTC aims at conducting thorough research into the skill development of such a huge labour force and focus them towards innovation, product development and quality enhancement.

Legal Supports

A large section of the Muslim population is stuck in legal complications due to lack of availability of timely, affordable legal support. HRTC aims to further study such needs and improve its Legal Support Cell.

The Legal Cell attends to the requirements of those Muslim families which are stuck in legal hassles due to lack of proper financial and legal support. Also, providing legal due diligence to small and medium Muslim businessmen is done on a regular basis.


